**VILLAGE OF CASS CITY – BOIL WATER ALERT** - The Village of Cass City, Department of Public Works (DPW) is advising residents living in the Northwood Lake Condo Association and Northwood Meadows Assisted Living Complex on the north end of the Village to boil their water until further notice as a precaution against possible bacterial contamination due to potential cross contamination by a local sprinkler system and Village water main. The DPW is flushing the system and samples will be tested during the next 48 hours. The “boil water” advisory is being done out of an abundance of caution.

This boil water advisory does not pertain to other areas of the Village of Cass City, only the Northwood Lake Condos and Northwood Meadows Assisted Living Complex.

Water should be brought to a boil, and allowed to boil for at least one minute. The DPW advises using bottled water as an alternative. Those using water from their faucets are cautioned to boil water they plan to use for drinking, brushing teeth, preparing food, making ice, giving to pets, coffee, and washing fruits and vegetables.
